Terms of Reference

Level

Standing Committee

Purpose

The Education Committee is a standing committee of the Dance Nova Scotia Board.

The role of the Committee is to:

- increase the understanding of the value of dance to arts integration
- improve the value added of the Dance 11 experience to all participants
- increase the professional development opportunities for dancers, teachers, instructors, choreographers, etc.
- establish connections with dance programs, clubs, societies in Post-Secondary institutes
- determine areas of educational need within the dance community
- develop and maintain an ongoing education plan
- recommend and/or update Dance Nova Scotia education policies
- research or develop resources for sharing for a Dance Nova Scotia resource-sharing site
- regularly review Dance Nova Scotia's involvement in the provincial governments Personal Development Credit

Membership

- Chair and Secretary as decided by the Committee
- Members: The Committee will consist of, at minimum, two Board members, the Executive Director, the Board President, and others as decided by the Committee

Meetings

- Frequency: At least quarterly

- Quorum: 50% plus 1

- Decision Making: Consensus

Minutes

Minutes of each meeting are recorded by the Secretary or an appointed delegate and distributed to Committee members and the Dance Nova Scotia Administrative Officer.

Reporting/Relationship

The Committee chair, or a designated committee member, will present a verbal report at regular Board meetings.

A written report from the committee is to be included as part of the Annual Report presented at the Annual General Meeting.
